

In the Shadow of the Fallen Towers written and illustrated by Don Brown (2021) Graphic Novel

Immersive reporting of events following the 9/11 attacks that quickly illuminates where we are 20+ years later.

A Series of Fortunate Events: Chance and the Making of the Planet, Life, and You by Sean B. Carroll (2020) Book, eBook, eAudiobook

For geology and biology fans, this book explores the role of chance in life and shows that accidents are more important than we might realize.

Whale Day: and other poems by Billy Collins (2020) Book A collection of poems by the former Poet Laureate of the U.S. and of New York State.

Tribe: On Homecoming and Belonging by Sebastian Junger (2016) Book, LP, BOCD, eBook, eAudiobook A blend of history and psychology that shows how societies experiencing war and its aftermath can learn much from veterans about humanity, health, and happiness.

World Of Wonders by Aimee Nezhukumatathil (2020) Book, BOCD, eBook Creative anecdotes about animals and the natural world.

Reflections by Rosa Parks by Rosa Parks with Gregory J. Reed (2017) Book, BOCD Words from a woman whose quiet strength and faith moved a nation towards justice.

Below Stairs: The Classic Kitchen Maid's Memoir that Inspired Upstairs, Downstairs and Downton Abbey by Margaret Powell (1968) Book, LP Tales of domestic service in London before and after WWII.

This is One Way to Dance by Sejal Shah (2020) Book, eBook A perceptive memoir in essays from a Rochester native.

Rochester Labor and Leisure by Donovan Shilling (2002) Book Experience Rochester in its heyday through photos and informative captions.

Two Old Women: An Alaska Legend of Betrayal, Courage, and Survival by Velma Wallis (1993) Book

An inspiring tale of two women who, abandoned by their tribe during a brutal winter famine, live to teach their tribe valuable lessons. Based on an Athabascan Indian legend.

The Final Solution by Michael Chabon (2004) Book, BOCD Sherlock Holmes is brought out of retirement to solve the murder of a man and the kidnapping of a German boy's parrot in 1944.

The Alchemist by Paulo Coelho (1993)

Book [English and Spanish], LP, BOCD, Book Discussion Kit, eBook, eAudiobook In this classic for philosophers and seekers, a boy travels the world finding truths and treasures.

The Sleeper and the Spindle by Neil Gaiman, illustrated by Chris Riddell (2015) Book, BOCD, Playaway, eBook, eAudiobook The familiar story of Sleeping Beauty, retold with twists.

Zorrie: A Novel by Laird Hunt (2021) Book, eBook A moving story of a hardscrabble life lived in the mid-west during and after the Depression.

Small Things Like These by Claire Keegan (2021) Book, eBook, eAudiobook In a small Irish town, in the days leading up to Christmas, a coal merchant takes on a difficult situation at the local convent.

Tiny Tales by Alexander McCall Smith (2020) Book, LP Thirty short stories exploring romance, ambition, kindness, and happiness, with cartoons designed by Iain McIntosh.

Sun-Daughters, Sea-Daughters by Aimee Ogden (2021) Book When the land-dwelling Vo are beset with plague, Atuale returns to the sea to ask the World-Witch for help.

Last Night at the Lobster by Stewart O'Nan (2007) Book, eBook The Lobster is closing for good, a snowstorm is brewing, and Manny manages the kitchen. Before the night is over, you'll feel like you own the place.

Strange Planet and **Stranger Planet** by Nathan W. Pyle (2019 and 2020) Books, eBooks Comics that will make you think twice about traditions and guirky English language.

Fox 8: A Story by George Saunders (2018) Book A fox's letter to humans ends with a request: "be nicer."

Another Brooklyn by Jacqueline Woodson (2016) Book, LP, BOCD, eBook, eAudiobook Four friends have each other's backs — until they don't.
