

Refugee 87 by Ele Fountain

In Ethiopia, fourteen-year-old Shif and his best friend Bini embark on a continentcrossing journey of survival after they are imprisoned and become refugees.



A Castle In The Clouds by Kerstin Dier

Way up in the Swiss mountains, there's an old grand hotel. Sophie, who works at the hotel as an intern, soon finds herself right in the middle of a perilous adventure, and at risk of losing not only her job but also her heart.



Beautiful Wild by Anna Godbersen

Five teenagers from the elite Hartwell Academy are on their way back to New York from an end-of-summer camping trip in Idaho when they realize that something has gone wrong; one of them has become violently ill, and their private plane has apparently been hijacked and is headed in the wrong direction



Playing With Fire by April Henry

When a fire engulfs an Oregon forest, a group of trapped hikers must find another way out



Run, Hide, Fight Back by April Henry

Told from multiple viewpoints, holiday shoppers struggle to survive as three masked shooters open fire in a crowded mall and five teens form a plan to stop them.



The Grace Year by Kim Liggett

Tierney James, sixteen, struggles to endure the year in which she and other young women are banished to the wild until, purified, the survivors are allowed to return home and marry.



Where The World Ends

by Geraldine McCoughrean

In the summer of 1727, Quill and his friends are put ashore on a remote sea stac to harvest birds for food, and only the end of the world can explain why no boat returns to collect them.



Be Not Far From Me by Mindy McGinnis

Lost in the Great Smoky Mountains, rising high school senior Ashley must fight for survival without any tools, growing in awareness that the world is not tame, and neither are people.



Wilder Girls by Rory Power

First the teachers died one by one. Then it began to infect the students, turning their bodies strange and foreign. Now, cut off from the rest of the world and left to fend for themselves on their island home, the students don't dare wander outside the Raxter School for Girls fence.



The Lost by Natasha Preston
