


# Romance Reads for Teens


## **Love at Full Tilt** by Jenny L. Howe


***I Hope This Doesn't Find You* by Ann Liang**

A bisexual teen girl tries to make her ex jealous by faking an Instagram romance that leads to surprisingly real feelings in this hijinks-filled rom-com.




***Twelfth Knight* by Alexene Farol Follmuth**


***Asking for a Friend* by Kara HL Chen**
