
The Rose Bargain (The Rose Bargain book 1) by Sasha Peyton Smith







Heartless Hunter (Crimson Moth book 1) by Kristin Ciccarelli


Hazelthorn by C.G. Drews


Destroy the Day (Defy the Night book 3) by Brigid Kemmerer
