


Prince of Glass and Midnight

A girl who paints the future and a cursed dragon lord, bound by love and deception, pair up in a plot to bring down the gods.




The Wishless Ones

by Alyssa Wees (2023)




Liar's Kingdom

by Erin A. Craig (2025)






The Severed Thread by Leslie Vedder (2023)


Upon a Starlit Tide by Kell Woods (2025)


A Sleep Like Death by Kalynn Bayron (2024)


Lady's Knight by Amie Kaufman
